PICTURES AND MEASUREMENTS

How to Take Pictures:

- Take pictures in the daylight for proper lighting
- Take at least four pictures to capture the entire room
- Take pictures of all the items you are keeping in the room

How to Take Measurements:

- Using a pencil, sketch out the existing layout and be sure to include the placement of all windows, doors & closets
- Use a tape measure to measure each wall, corner to corner, record the sizes and locations of all openings, doorways and built-ins.
- Measure each wall in detail (start at one corner of the room, measure the distance from the corner to the outside edge of the window casing, from there to the opposite edge of the window casing, from there to the corner of the room).
- When finished, total the measurement and it should match the first overall measurement. Continue this process around the room and note the measurements on your drawing.
- Note location of electrical outlets
